Indicators	: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Household Data (Age, sex, educational qualification, marital status)• Socio-Economic Particulars (House ownership, no. of rooms, source of water, type of toilet, electricity, have radio, TV, mobile, distance from home to Union Parishad, Upazila Sadar, nearest health center, primary & secondary school, insurance, mfi membership)• Family assets, savings & investment (land, house, livestock, poultry & fisheries, agricultural equipment, business resource, transport, furniture & others, financial assets & savings, financial debt)• Income from different sources (Crop production, forest resource, different type of rent/mortgage, self-employed farm/business/industry/transport/services, wage, service, remittance, pension and SSNP)• Loan and savings (Loan amount, loan outstanding, interest, no. of installment, sector of loan use, informal loan, savings amount, uses of loan, assets sell, loan uses in productive work, giving loan)• Education (reason for not going to school, asset sold to meet cost, receive loan for study, current studying status, age, institution, exam result, got scholarship, studying cost)• Disease and treatment (Type of diseases, receive treatment, , mode of service, treatment cost, sale any assets for treatment, receive any loan for treatment etc.)• Crisis Management (name of natural calamity, time, type of losses, amount of asset loss, direct income decrease, sources of remedy)• Cost of food and nonfood items (Weekly expense for food consumption, yearly expense on daily use products and services & clothing / consumer durable products, and various other items)• Socio economic changes (overall development of livelihood, food, natural disaster, increase income opportunity, education facility, treatment, crisis management power)
