Course Brief:

Financial Analysis course is developed to help people working in the microfinance field to obtain basic analytical skills to use financial information. It is intended for managers and executives of micro-finance organisations to evaluate financial health of the entity. Particularly, this course aims to train non-finance executives with several financial statement analysis techniques such as, common size statement analysis, ratio analysis, break-even analysis, time series or trend analysis etc.

Target Participants:

This course is primarily designed for the Executives, Branch Managers and Senior Managers, who are from non-finance background.

Course Objectives:

After completion of the programme, participants will be able to:

- **IDENTIFY** components, relationships and importance of financial statements.
- **UNDERSTAND** various financial statements and their implications for financial decision purposes.
- **UNDERSTAND** the analysis framework for financial statements from user's perspective.
- **REVIEW** and interpret financial statements by applying different tools and techniques, such as financial ratios, break-even analysis, time series or trend analysis.
