

## Brief on Financial Management for MFIs

Duration: 5 Days

Language: Bangla (Native Language) and English

### Course Brief:

Many executives, branch managers and CEOs of Microfinance institutions have non-business academic backgrounds. The aim of this course is to equip these executives with particular financial skills so that they will be able to handle and manage both short term and long term issues related to financial management. This course aims to train MFI executives to manage working capital, exposure to credit risk, and evaluate profitability of long term projects.

### Target Participants:

This course is primarily designed for the Executives, Branch Managers and Senior Managers, who are from non-finance background.

### Course Objectives:

After completion of the programme, participants will be able to:

- **GAIN** insight on the sources and usage of funds for MFIs.
- **EXPLAIN** the contents and purpose of financial statements, i.e., balance sheet, income statement and differentiate between short term and long term contents.
- **UNDERSTAND** the determinants of interest and how the value of money changes over time and to calculate present values of future cash flows.
- **INSPECT** the components of working capital and study the different working capital loans.
  
- **UNDERSTAND** the impact of leverage on business operations.
- **ACQUIRE** sound knowledge on the contemporary issues of financial management for MFIs.
